Best Bet: Smilin' Del (race 8), Longshot: Dublin Road (race 1)

Race One Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#6 DUBLIN ROAD set sail on an above par pace and held the show on Sept 7th (blinkers on). 57% wire jobs at this turf distance, and she could shake loose early.

#9 HAND OVER HAND is out of solid grass sire Grand Slam, and Morris Nicks is 23% with debut turf runners. Leading rider hops aboard the live firster.

#2 GAMMA RAY switched to turf and missed by a head while clear of the rest last time. She earned best last race speed rating for her efforts. Runs two alike?

Race Two Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#4 O NIGHT DIVINE turns back for the resurgent Wes Hawley, and Torres shows up here. Not much pace in the paper race, and she ran well at 7f in Aug.

#3 COUNT ON LYNN has shown marked improvement since moving to the Tony Richey barn in July. She figures all over an expected tepid early pace.

#1 TWINING'S CAT cuts back in distance and reunites with Zimmerman, who rode her to a pair of show finishes earlier in the meet. Profitable barn.

Race Three Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#10 OH BABY BABY made up 11 lengths in respectable 5th place finish in Evangeline bow. Shawn David is an impressive 44% with 2nd time starters.

#8 MI STORMY finished an above par 2nd when dropped to this level on Aug 9th, and show finisher was a next out winner. Barn 21% with this type of returnee.

#4 ZUPPARDO'SALLUSION earned improved pace figs in the mud 2nd time out. Barn 38% with this type of dropper, and he looms a pace factor at the very least.

Race Four Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#3 FOREIGN PRODUCTION earned triple digit speed rating in the stakes ranks (slop) last time. Stalking type loves this oval and should beat these.

#2 KILLING ME came again to miss by a head in turf sprint return, and barn is 21% 2nd off the shelf. Earned triple digit speed fig in '08 dirt sprint stakes tally.

#6 RANGER DANGER has fired in all four career starts and has three wire job wins to show for his efforts. Major pace player is 1st start in five months.

Race Five Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#6 KYLIE'S DREAM experienced a troubled beginning and recovered to finish 4th of 12 in local dirt sprint bow. Her dam has tossed a pair of turf winners.

#7 DIXIE TUNES showed marked improvement in her 2nd career start here. Dam has thrown two turf winners, and barn is 22% with first turf runners.

#8 CANDY DELICIOUS is out of 15% grass sire Candy Ride, and dam has tossed three turf winners. Sports a local bullet for profitable 18% turf trainer.

Race Six Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#2 HELLA BELLA was clearly 2nd best in a 6f sprint here last time. She is 2-23 lifetime, and both wins occurred in local extended sprints. Pace player.

#5 ACTION PACKED DAY dueled and just missed the place in a local route on Sept 11th. Cart is 37% 1st off the claim, and she should move up 3rd off the shelf.

#12 HALF A SPLASH beat my top in a *three lifetime* sprint last time. All three career wins accomplished here, including one at this distance. Profitable barn.

Race Seven Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#4 DANCINGWITHNOMUSIC drops to her lowest level off a layoff, and she ran into repeat winner *Wings of Joy* last time. She hails from a profitable turf outfit.

#5 JUDICIARY graduated over the local green on July 12th, and she has been on the main in both starts against winners. She reunites with leading rider today.

#10 BLONDIE'S MEADOW was clearly 2nd best in the local slop on Sept 13th. She was only beaten 1.25 lengths in latest turf start versus similar here in August.

Race Eight Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#6 SMILIN' DEL appears to be sitting on a top as he stretches back out 3rd off the shelf. Torres hops aboard, and 2-time local winner fired in all 3 routes this year.

#2 MARQUEE EVENT is now under the care of trainer Michelle Lovell, and she's 27% with layoff runners and 33% *blinkers off*. Leading rider here.

#10 SIMPLE KIND OF MAN graduated at first asking in a local turf sprint, and place finisher came back to score. Tries a dirt route for quality connections.

Race Nine Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#3 DR RUSHING finished an even 4th from post 11 in the mud last time. Lone win occurred at this extended sprint distance, and Torres takes the call for solid barn.

#1 AFLEET TRICK dives in class, switches surfaces, and turns back in distance. He broke his maiden for \$5k at seven panels and looms an inside pace factor.

#5 MARQUIS MARKSMAN improved significantly to graduate off a layoff in his 2nd career start. Hustling apprentice sticks, and barn is 24% 2nd off the shelf.
