Race One Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#9 EULOGIZE FASHION disappointed in the mud at 2-1 last time. Earned competitive speed ratings in first two outings and might go better on fast ground.

#7 IMA JEAN'S DREAM makes her first start in over seven months. Goes 2nd time tag and reunites with Simington, who rode to a MSW show finish Nov. '08.

#5 BITTER JONES ran into a runaway winner in her first start for a tag when last seen in July. Stretches out in distance and looms a pace factor at the very least. .

Race Two Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#1A HAPPYFROMTHEGITGO is 3 for 3 on a fast track, and that includes a pair of state bred stakes wins. Asmussen charge is a prominent throughout threat.

#4 BABY REESE earned above par pace figs in the mud on Sept 7th. She ended up a solid 3rd in career bow and might be the one to catch under young apprentice.

#6 PASS IT DOWN is another maiden 2nd timer trying stakes foes. She battled on a fast pace and was 3rd of 12 in local bow in the slop. Could improve.

Race Three Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#7 TAYLORS SISTER has been slowly improving for a profitable maiden claiming barn. Her late run could be much more effective at seven panels.

#6 MSDIAMONDCITY added lasix for her new barn and was clearly 2nd best off a layoff last time. Has tactical speed as she cuts back to an extended sprint

#9 ELEGANT PANACHE earned an above par speed rating in rallying show finish in lone try at this level on Aug 28th. She'll be finishing under hustling apprentice.

Race Four analysis by Jarrod Horak

#5 RED RALLY has faced much better company at Saratoga, Colonial, and Churchill. Owns fine early-pressing speed and should go better around one turn.

#6 BRAVE DAY scratched out of a MSW affair on Oct 1st in favor of this. Dam has tossed a pair of winners, and she had an improved work on Sept 24th.

#2 PONCHO AND PEDRO earned best last race late pace fig in sharp maiden claiming win on Sept 6th. If the pace gets crazy he could pick up the pieces.

Race Five Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#5 ENTICING GIRL earned a quality speed fig in sharp debut sprint tally here, and she was 8th in turf route stake last time. Leading rider hops aboard.

#1 ARCTIC WINTER is the one to catch from the rail. She dueled and weakened in 1st start versus winners last time. Broke maiden by many lengths.

#3 SASS IN THE CITY has done nothing wrong in a pair of local dirt sprint tallies to kick off career. Rallied through traffic to win last time. Faces tougher today.

Race Six Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#5 HOLY JOSY is sitting on a turf win following a pair of place finishes, and she missed by a head last time. Owns best finishing kick and should score.

#7 SHE'SAMARK broke through with an easy maiden score in a race originally scheduled for turf last time. Fired big shots in both local turf route outings.

#1 WILDCAT LIL scurries up the ladder and returns to the turf following a rallying pace finish off a layoff at 6f. Has been part of trifecta in 4 of 10 turf starts.

Race Seven Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#6 BRASSY BOY looks tough at low odds. Won 1st two outings and landed show behind next out graded winner *Backtalk* in Bashford Manor (G3) at CD.

#4 COMEDORO earned quality speed rating in romping debut sprint tally. Barn clicking at a 30% rate here, and Torres hops aboard early-pressing threat.

#1 SATELLITE TRICK is out of 29% debut sire Stark Ridge, and dam has thrown 11 winners (2 stakes winners) from as many starters. Ambitiously placed.

Race Eight Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#1 IVOR'S EMPIRE finished 4th as my best bet last time. He fell way behind and was left with too much to do that day. Part of exacta in 5 of 7 local turf starts.

#2 ROYAL TREATY is a gem of consistency with five straight top three finishes, including a pair over the local weeds. Stalk and pounce trip anticipated.

#5 MEDIGATING dueled on a fast pace and stopped last time. Was in good form here prior to that and could find himself controlling the tempo in this spot.

Race Nine Analysis by Jarrod Horak

#7 RESTLESS STAR has been part of exacta in all four local dirt starts, and he won easily the last time he sprinted over the local main. Torres hops aboard.

#9 ELEUTHERA romped by open lengths in recent extended sprint *two lifetime* claimer in the slop. Stalk and pounce type has won on a fast track as well.

#10 LABELED dons the hood and shows up in the Lovell shedrow off the shelf. Sharp trainer is 26% with new additions, and Zimmerman is 2 for 3 with barn.

Race 10 analysis by Jarrod Horak

#3 INDEPENDENT MISS rates a longshot look as Torres had options but ended up here. Dam has tossed 3 turf winners, and she exits 2nd in the Evangeline mud.

#5 HAD TO BEE stopped on the main last time, and you can draw a line through that as she does not like dirt. Early-pressing type can rebound on the grass.

#4 BERRY DELIGHTFUL was my top for turf last time, but I downgraded her chances when the race was transferred, and she ran last. Should go better on turf. .
